Message from the SACC President, Jan van Rooyen

Dear SACC Members

The year is in full swing and when you read this, the first few SACC shows will be something of the past. Through the grapevine I hear that there are a lot of promising COTY candidates that will hit the show bench this year and this makes the art of showing so much more exciting. I also heard that there will be a lot of new faces at the shows and a lot of exhibitors that have not shown for some time will again be showing this year. To all of you, welcome in the SACC show ring.

The year proves to be difficult for most people and even in the cat fancy the current economy and credit crunch has reared its ugly head. Internationally there are reports of breeders that do not mate their queens at the moment, because there is just no market to sell kittens. Kittens from the previous breeding season are still unsold. Shelters for dogs and cats are overpopulated because people can just not look after their pets anymore. As far as I know this has not been the case in South Africa yet. I do urge each responsible breeder to plan for these situations. The predictions being made is that this phase of the economy will remain with us for the next 3 years,

so it is quite important to prepare oneself for what lies ahead. I received some correspondence of discussions on some of the cat lists regarding the prices of cat food. The fact remains that whatever you as breeder or cat owner decide to feed your cats, one should not compromise on the quality of food that one feed your animals. I request from anyone that want to get into discussions with any food supplier, irrespective if it is about price or discount for certain groups of people that it is done in a professional and most appropriate manner. If there is a group of people that want SACC to lobby on their behalf specific requirements with the food suppliers, please channel those requests through the correct channel. My advice to all of you is:

- Only keep the amount of animals that you can comfortably care for in situations where the economy is good or bad.
- If you need to buy or import that next show winning cat, please be true to your self and admit if you cannot afford another mouth to feed. There will always be another opportunity.
- Do not compromise on the quality of food you feed your cats. If you need to switch to another brand or method of feeding, make sure that your beloved cats are still provided with the necessary nutrients required in any feline diet.

A lot of exciting things are planned for this year. Our kitten show will be held this year in conjunction with the Gardenex Expo. Although the venue is familiar, the vibe will be different to other shows that are held in The Coca-Cola Dome in Gauteng. The National Show is

planned for 6 June 2009 and COTY for 1 August 2009. Details will be made available soon.

I am also proud to announce that SACC managed to secure a generous sponsorship with Royal Canin for 2009. Royal Canin sponsored shows will be held in almost all regions this year. Royal Canin will also sponsor COTY this year again, as well as a SACC representative to attend the World Cat Congress (WCC) that will be held this year in Arnhem, The Netherlands. The agreement between SACC and Royal Canin to provide discount vouchers to breeders for all kittens transferred into the name of the new owners will also continue this year. Read further on in this issue regarding the detail to qualify for these discount vouchers.

I am the lucky one to represent SACC at WCC in April 2009. As this is my first opportunity to represent SACC at WCC, I am quite looking forward to attend the seminar and meetings to be held over this time. At the one meeting, SACC will lead the discussion to provide a proper channel to address the situations where cats are imported and the purchaser do not receive the cat or registration papers. Too many times in the past SACC breeders have spent a lot of money to import a cat and then either the cat never arrives or the cat arrives without the necessary papers to register it within SACC. I hope at this meeting to at least agree on a foundation of how issues like this will be addressed between the members of WCC.

The provisional dates for the SACC governing delegates to meet this year are:

- 7 June 2009 – Business Meeting
- 24 October 2009 – AGM
- 25 October 2009 – Business Meeting

Please take note of these dates so that you are aware of when proposals received will be discussed.

Have a good show season and I am looking forward to meeting you all again in the coming weeks.

In General:

Breeders and Members are reminded that they can apply for a DM (Distinguished Merit) title for their cats. This title is added as a suffix to the name of the cat and based on the show success of the

cat's progeny, according to the following point system:

- Champion / Premier 1 point
- Grand Champion / Premier 2 point
- Supreme Champion / Premier 3 points

Progeny of status to the total value of 30 points will earn a male the DM title.

Progeny of status to the total value of 10 points to earn a female the DM title. Only the highest title obtained by a particular cat will count towards DM status for its parents (i.e. a Supreme Champion earns its parents 3 points, not 1+2+3 points).

Breeders are requested to please use the new Breed and Colour Codes when registering Kittens.

The SACC official Standard of Points (incorporating the new Breed and colour codes) is available from the S.A. Cat Register.

Applications for registration are still repeatedly delayed or returned to members. Please take note that each Application form lays down the rules and requirements for the service required.

Reasons for applications being delayed or returned to members:

Kitten registrations:

No pedigree forms for kittens attached
No application for Registration form (SACR F3) attached
No mating certificate from stud owner submitted.
Breed numbers and breed descriptions do not correlate - (The standard of points is available at R10-00 per issue from the SACR

Pedigrees and application forms not signed.

Fees incorrect or omitted
Annual Cattery name renewal (Breeder fee) - outstanding.

Stud registrations:

Application to register a stud (SACR F1) - not completed and stamped by a Veterinarian.

Registration of an imported cat:

Application to register an imported cat (SACR F3b) – omitted.
Pedigree forms and transfers (into the new owner's name) from the governing body of the country of origin - omitted.

Registration of a cat registered with another SA Association:

Application form (SACR F3c) – omitted.
Pedigree form and transfer (into the new owner's name) from the governing body – omitted.

Transfer forms:

Previous owner / breeder to sign
New owner's detail incomplete or not signed.

(The new owners SACC Cattery name can be added as a suffix to the cat's name at a cost of R25-00 in addition to the transfer fee.)

Breed Council Secretary's Report

Dear Breed Group Secretaries and members

Reminders to Breed groups

I would like to remind you that your affiliation fees to SACC for 2009 should be paid by 1 June 2009. If it has not been done yet, please do it as soon as possible. Payments are to be made to the **office of the SA Cat Register**. Affiliation fees are R75.00 and must be accompanied by the membership list and annual balance sheet of the Breed Group. This list should indicate voting and non-voting members.

Please note that Breed Groups that do not pay their affiliation fees will

lose their affiliation to SACC as well as the rights the breeders fought so long for. Even if you do not have proposals on the ballot sheet every year, there might be issues on the General Ballot that need your members' vote!

Proposals for amendments to the Constitution regarding Breed Group Rules/Breed Council Rules or the Standard of Points should be sent to the Breed Group Secretary for inclusion on the voting ballot on or before **31 July 2009**. Please go through the Breed Group Rules and Constitution to see the correct procedures for submitting proposals.

Proposals for amendment to the SACC Constitution or Show Rules should be done through your clubs.

See the following excerpt from the rules.....

Procedures for Submission of Proposals to Breed Council:

- 3.1 Breed Group members shall forward suggestions and proposals to the elected secretary of the specific Breed Group.
- 3.2 The Breed Group Secretary (e.g. Siamese Breeders Group of SA's secretary) shall obtain the opinions of other members of that Breed Group as well as those of **other Breed Groups representing the same breeds.**
- 3.3 These proposals shall be discussed and refined within the Breed Groups and amongst Groups representing the same breeds and become the basis for the final

Proposals to be sent to the Breed Council Secretary.

- 3.4 Proposals with their motivations should be submitted to the Breed Council Secretary no later than **31 July of each year.**

It is the responsibility of the Breed Groups to ensure that they are fulfilling all the requirements as set out in the SACC Constitution. They can get a copy from their local club delegates or me. The Breed Group and Breed Council Rules have remained unchanged in the last five years and you should have them on file.

Unless the Standard of Points for your particular breed includes a list of outcross breeds, kittens resulting from outcross breedings will not be registered.

If you feel that your breed needs outcrossing to other breeds for health reasons or to enlarge the gene pool, please ensure that your Breed Group proposes that such outcross breeds should be added to your Breed Standard for inclusion in the Breed Council Ballot for voting.

Kitten transfer and Voucher System

In conjunction with Royal Canin, SACC will continue in 2009 the Kitten Transfer and Voucher System. This is due to the success of this initiative in 2008. SACC can definitely confirm that there was an increase in the transfer of kittens from breeder to new owners. With Royal Canin that will also increase their database of clients, this is definitely a win-win situation for both organizations.

The system works as follows:

- A breeder, who sells a kitten and transfer the kitten into the name of the new owner, will receive a R10 voucher per kitten that can be used for discount with the next order of food. This is getting R10 back for the R20 it costs to transfer

the kitten. In order to use the voucher the breeder:

- Must be on the Crown Partners Program;
- Must order a minimum of 20kg of food per order;
- Must use the discount against a cat food product and not a dog food product;
- The vouchers must be faxed to the sales office with the order and then be given to the driver on delivery of the order.
- The new owner of the kitten will receive a voucher for a free 2kg bag of kitten food that can be collected at the closest veterinary practice. The value of this voucher is around R130.

There is definitely a lot of benefit in joining the Royal Canin Breeder Program. These are:

Eastern Province Cat Club

The **EASTERN PROVINCE CAT CLUB** was founded in the early days of the Cat Fancy in South Africa and one of the young founder members, **Avice Henderson**, is still very active in the Club as a breeder and exhibitor of Burmese cats. Avice imported several Burmese cats which have had a big impact on the modern South African Burmese. Indeed, just last Saturday (7th March 2009) Avice was there cheering on her beautiful Lilac Burmese female, **Supreme Champion Yangon Khin Kin**, bred by Hazel King.

The more recent era has seen the number of shows within a season increase from just one, with each cat on show being judged once, to three or four shows each having anything between three to six judging rings. Shows have been held at a variety of venues including the famous Feathermarket Hall where the shows were managed by the legendary **“Bubbles” Masters**. The show has now settled in its favoured venue, the Walmer Town Hall where the shows were run by the late, lamented **Elaine Michel**, a SACC judge and where she trained the present show manager, **Johan Groenewald**.

At all times the character of the shows has attempted to reflect the character of the city of Port Elizabeth itself. This is the “Friendly City” and the EPCC Committee works hard to ensure that visitor and regulars alike leave the show hall happy and content with the experience.

There are ways in which the Club Committee tries to achieve this. The first thing the exhibitor sees in the entrance hall is long-time member, **Ronnie Gerber**, greeting and relieving them of their entrance fee. Club Secretary, **David Hessey**, is also there with the Club Information stall.

There are other attractions in the form of trade stalls and the fund-raising stall of **Port Elizabeth CAT CARE**.

Once in the show hall, there is the refreshment area also organised and run by Cat Care. The Eastern Province Cat Club makes no charge for these Cat Care stalls and all profits made go to Cat Care. This area is totally discreet and affords a space where exhibitors can relax and gossip!

Eastern Province Cat Club members have always had the problem of exhibitors putting their fingers into the exhibits’ cages. To avoid this, a **CUDDLE CORNER** was established with cats and kittens able to be handled and stroked by members of the public who are educated in the process of disinfection between “cuddles” and the correct way to handle cats and kittens. This has proved hugely popular with public and exhibitors alike.

When **Best In Show** comes around, EPCC has evolved a system which seems fair in that it clearly rewards the very best cats in the show but also recognises those which are a step forward in breeder achievement and quality.

Each judge has an individual Breed Award to give. This may be for any single aspect of achievement or for achievement over a period of

time. Secondly, each judge is encouraged to list Best Adult, Kitten and Neuter in each show category, the important point of this being that these cats may not actually appear in a judge’s Top Twelve placements but are worthy of being recognised by the public and exhibitors generally. This is called the **Best Of Breed** as it covers all breeds and categories during the show day.

Finally there are the **Top Twelve** exhibits. These are calculated to be the twelve exhibits who have received the most number of nominations from the judges. The judges list in no particular order and from any show category the very best twelve exhibits that judge has handled during the day. Generally speaking four nominations in a six ring show tends to see an exhibit into the Top Twelve.

These cats are then judged (always by visiting judges) against the ideal for the breed and placed 1 – 12. A highlight of every show is the countdown from 12th place through to acclaim for the Cat of the Day.

No system is ever perfect and the Club Committee is always attempting to refine and improve and constantly asks for input though the Club Newsletter, **“In Hot Pursuit”**

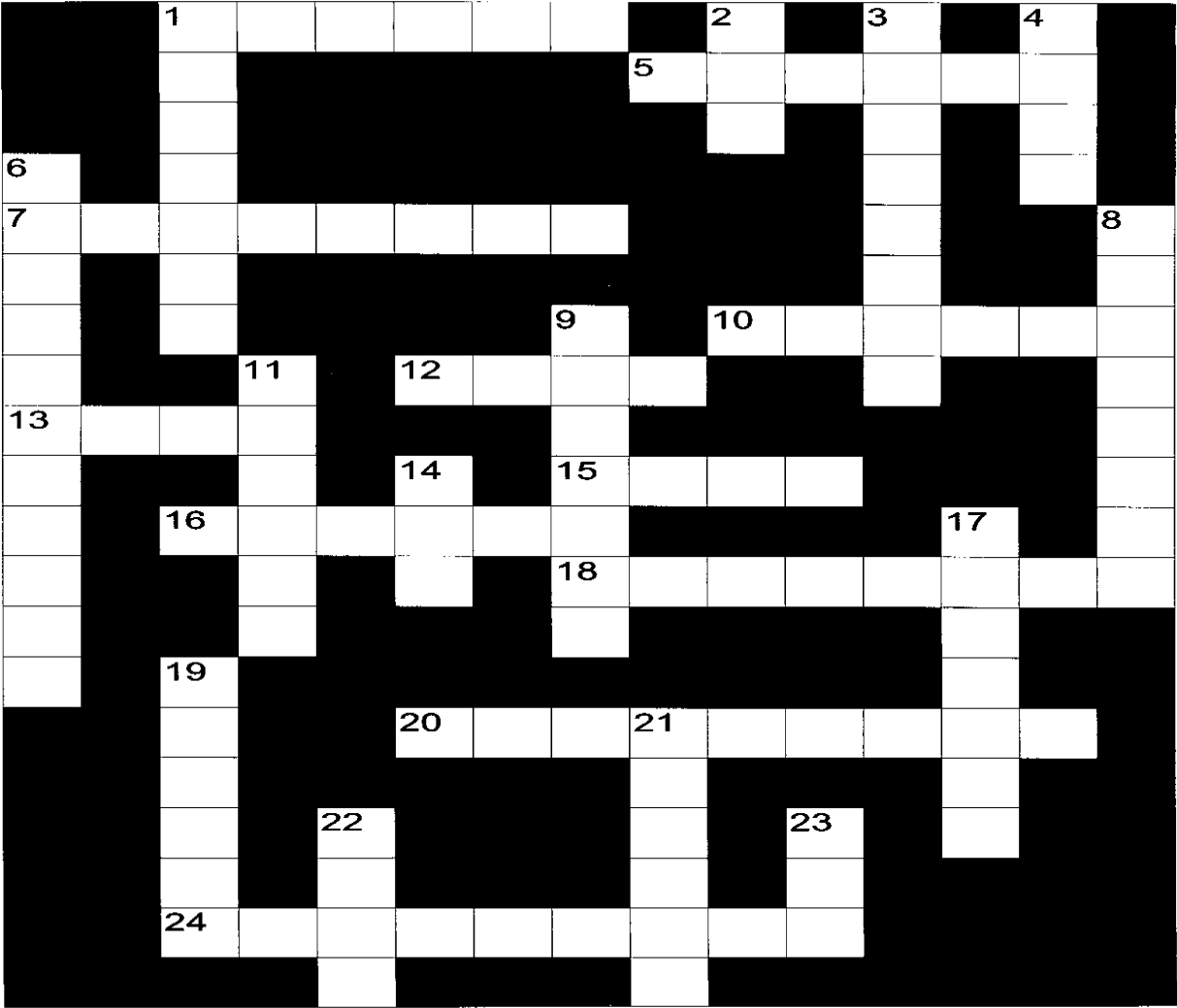
