



## THE S A CAT REGISTER

### FIRST TIME REGISTRATIONS (SACR D1a)

All Applicants must be a member of a club affiliated to the Southern Africa Cat Council.

In addition, the following rules apply:

- Please read the SACC Breeder Guidelines first (SACR F2a) As a Breeder you will be expected to sign a copy annually, that you will adhere to the Guidelines.
- Secondly, complete an application to register a cattery name (SACR F2).
- When you wish to register a **cat, or a litter of kittens**, complete the application for registration (SACR F3).
- Also, prepare a complete, four-generation pedigree form for each cat or kitten being registered. (SACR F3a). Alternatively, to apply for SACC generated pedigrees, forward a copy of the official SACC registered Sire & Dam pedigrees with your application.
- To register a stud, which must be done when he begins working, or when he is 18 months old, whichever is the sooner, complete the application for stud registration (SACR F1).
